

Visiting Student FAQ's

Can I get financial aid from Creighton?

If you are a student at another university, you can obtain federal loans from your home school. Your school should send a consortium agreement to our Office of Financial Aid. Creighton will provide information on applicable tuition and fees.

If you are taking courses for license renewal, certifications or career development you may want to consider private or alternative loans.

Exam Requirements – All Programs

Even though you have not enrolled in a course with synchronous time requirement's, exams are given on a specific day and with specific windows of time. You may need to withdraw from a course if you will not be able to be available during the exam window time.

Not all classes listed offer a final exam. If you require a class that offers a final exam, it is your responsibility to verify with the class IOR that this requirement will be met with the class being offered.

Can I complete coursework whenever I want?

Pharmacy: Not always. There are some synchronous courses and test times that will require you to be online at the time set by the instructor. Contact Jeanne Riha (402-2803296) or jmriha@creighton.edu for more specific information.

Occupational Therapy: Yes, for Occupational Therapy courses there are no synchronous components in courses and there are no exams.

Is there a maximum number of hours I can take?

Approval of course load will be granted by the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs. Specific course requests and online course experience will be considered.

Can I audit a class?

Yes, you can audit a class but you will be charged tuition. Practicing health professionals may be eligible for additional discounts. Please refer to the website:
